Dear Families:

In just a few days, we kick off our Catholic Schools Week celebration! It's an exciting time for our students because of the fun and unique activities that are planned, but it's also a time to reflect on our mission and focus on our Catholic Identity. After all, that is at the heart of what we do!

Every educator has their favorite "teacher movie," a film that they most relate to. For me, it was—and continues to be—*Mr. Holland's Opus*, the story of a struggling musician who becomes a music teacher to support his family. He goes into the job reluctantly, but by the end dreads retirement. Says Mr. Holland, "I got dragged into this gig kicking and screaming, and now it's the only thing I want to do."

During his first few months on the job, Mr. Holland begins to question his choice. He does his job, but the principal sees that he's just going through the motions. She stops Mr. Holland in the hallway one day and shares her concerns. He's confused, and responds, "Mrs. Jacobs, I get here on time every morning, don't I? I'm doing my job the best I can."

It is Mrs. Jacobs's reply that always "sticks with me." She tells Mr. Holland, "A teacher is two jobs. Fill young minds with knowledge, yes. But more important, give those minds a compass so that that knowledge doesn't go to waste. Now, I don't know what you're doing with the knowledge, Mr. Holland, but as a compass, you're stuck."

That is what Catholic Education is all about—and that is the reason I became a teacher. You can get an education from any school, but a Catholic school is that "compass." That is what makes us different. That is what makes our school special, and that is what we're really celebrating during Catholic Schools Week!

It's no coincidence that the symbol of our school is the lighthouse. Like a compass, it offers direction and guidance. 
