## Policies and Procedures for Report Card Distribution on Thursday, December 7, 2023

November 29, 2023

Dear Families:

Believe it or not, we have reached the end of the first trimester! Since we're closing out this marking period, your child will soon receive his or her first report card. Students in kindergarten through grade eight will receive their child's report card via email on Thursday, December 7<sup>th</sup>. Students in 3K and Pre-K will get paper report cards sent home with their child on Thursday, December 7<sup>th</sup>.

The purpose of this letter is to serve as a reminder that report card meetings are not mandatory because you already met with your child's teacher for progress reports back in October. We will still have conferences, but these will be at the teacher's request and discretion. A teacher may require a meeting for a variety of reasons including but not limited to a student's academic progress, conduct, or social-emotional growth. Any request a teacher makes for a meeting is mandatory.

For students in grades five through eight, it has been customary for teachers to meet with just the homeroom teacher for parent-teacher conferences. Since meetings are now at the teachers' discretion, teachers may request meetings with the parents of students *outside* of their homeroom, if they feel it is necessary.

Parents will be notified of a required meeting via email on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 5<sup>th</sup></u>. In this email, there will be a link to sign up for a conference with your child's teacher. <u>Conferences times will be 1pm through 3pm on Thursday</u>, <u>December 7<sup>th</sup></u>. If you cannot participate in a conference at that time, please contact the teacher to arrange one prior to the Christmas recess.








Although it is a dress down day, students are reminded to dress with modesty. Students should adhere to the following attire as described in the **Parent-Student Handbook**:


