Dear Families:

All of you know me by the name Mr. Wilson, but when I was thirteen years old, I went by the name of Simon for a short time. I'll explain...

When I was in eighth grade, my class performed the Passion Play, a dramatic presentation that depicts the Passion of Jesus: his trial, suffering, death, and resurrection. The "script" for the play was taken primarily from this week's Palm Sunday Gospel.

Although it was 25 years ago, I still remember the parts I played. I was Simon of Cyrene, the man who helped Jesus carry his cross. Since there were more roles in the play than students in our class, many of us were assigned dual roles, so in addition to playing Simon, I was also a member of the crowd during Jesus' trial. I still remember my line: "What further need have we of witnesses? You have heard the blasphemy!"

Needless to say, I was a little bit disappointed with our teacher's casting decisions. Simon doesn't say anything, and the one line I had as "person in the crowd" helps to condemn Jesus! Now, almost three decades later, I don't mind my roles in the Saint Bernadette School Class of 2000 Passion Play. In fact, I think they're pretty significant and dare I say even symbolic!

At some point in our lives, we all are both the "person in the crowd" and Simon. We all have moments in our lives when we our words are hurtful and cruel; we "crucify" others with our lies and gossip. That said, we also have times when we redeem ourselves, when we offer charity, kindness, and a helping hand. In those times, we're Simon.

It's easy to put people down with our words, but how often do we support others through our actions? Although Simon doesn't say anything, his role is crucial. There is no salvation without crucifixion. Does Jesus make it to Calvary without Simon there to help carry the cross? While I didn't have a starring role, I think my portrayal of Simon gives Best Supporting Actor a whole new meaning!




